### SOUTH LEE PUPILS EXCEL IN NATIONAL BEBRAS CHALLENGE

Three pupils from South Lee Prep School & Nursery have achieved exceptional success in the national Bebras Challenge, with Percy B, Lennon P, and Henry D earning Gold Certificates for placing in the top 10% nationally. In addition, 12 other pupils were awarded Distinctions: Elizabeth C, Bruce F, Samantha L, Lily G, Thomas W, Derrick D, Mollie P, Alton R, Harry R, Molly F, David OSJ, and Luke S.



The Bebras Challenge introduces computational thinking to pupils worldwide, with over 3 million participants from more than 80 countries last year. Open to pupils aged 6 to 19, the challenge involves completing interactive online tasks that encourage logical thinking and problem-solving. Each participant has 45 minutes to tackle a variety of challenges, with tasks marked automatically by the competition system.

Mrs. Sarah Catchpole, Head of South Lee Prep School & Nursery, commented, "We are incredibly proud of our pupils for their success in the Bebras Challenge. This competition provides a fantastic opportunity for them to develop their computational thinking and problem-solving skills—essential abilities in today's digital world. It's wonderful to see so many of our pupils excelling on a national level."

Mr. Simon Clinch, Head of Digitally Enhanced Learning at South Lee Prep, added, "The Bebras Challenge offers our pupils an engaging way to apply their computational thinking to real-world problems. It encourages them to develop digital skills that will serve them well throughout their education and beyond."

Organised by the Raspberry Pi Foundation in partnership with the University of Oxford, the Bebras Challenge is designed to allow pupils from all backgrounds, whether strong in maths or computing or not, to demonstrate their potential.
